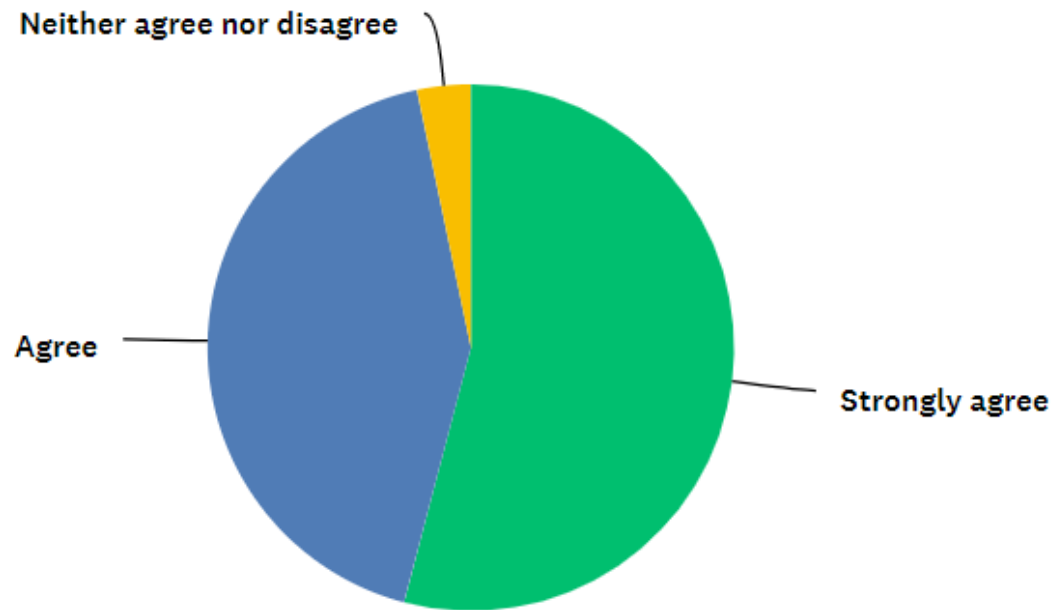

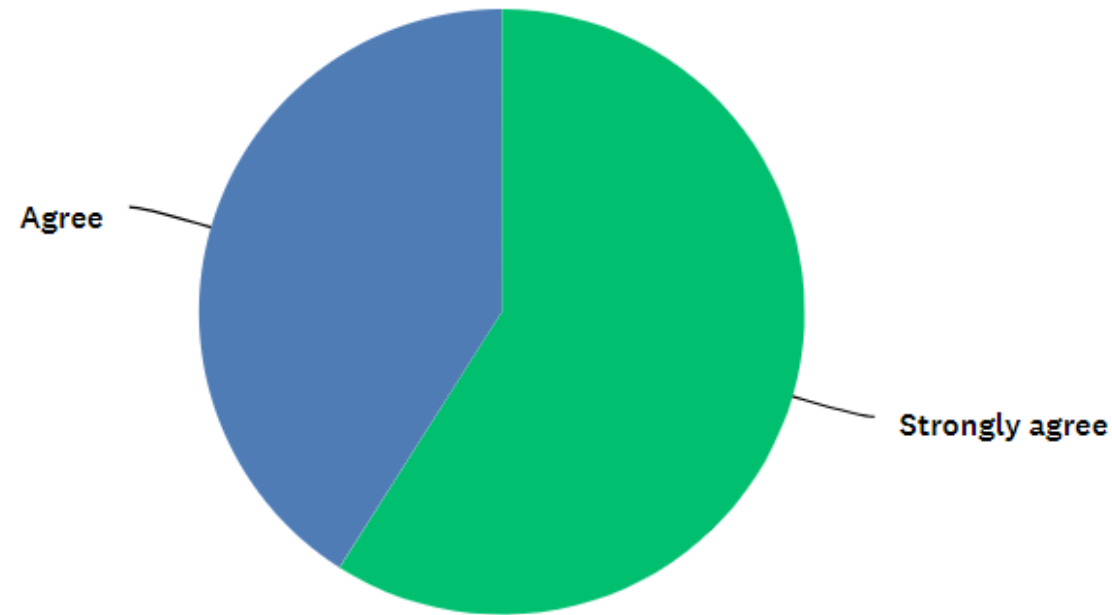
How much do you agree with the following statement?The day was about the right length

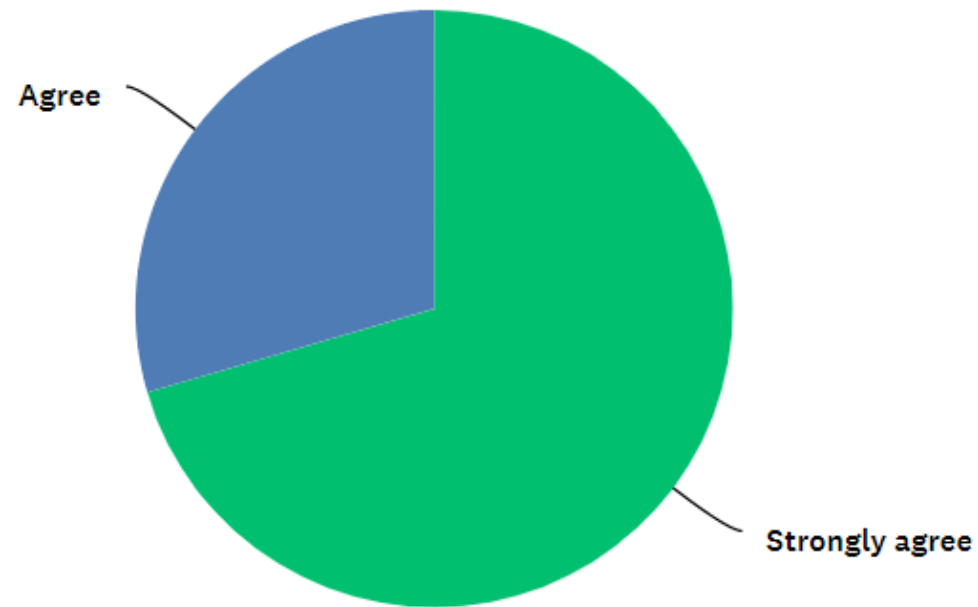
How much do you agree with the following statement?The day was well organised, I knew when and how to log on, and how to ask questions

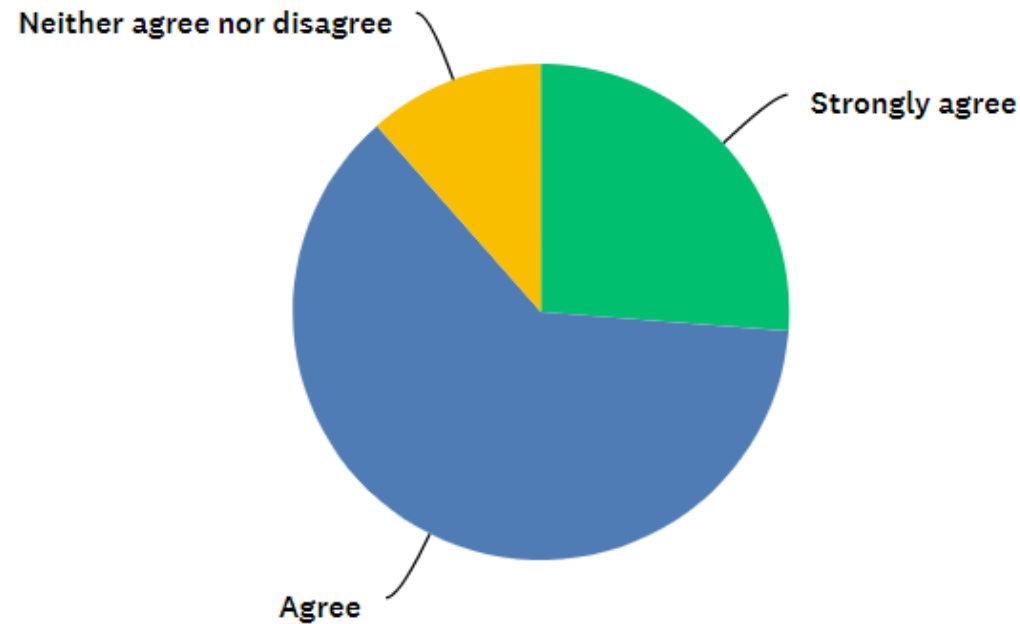

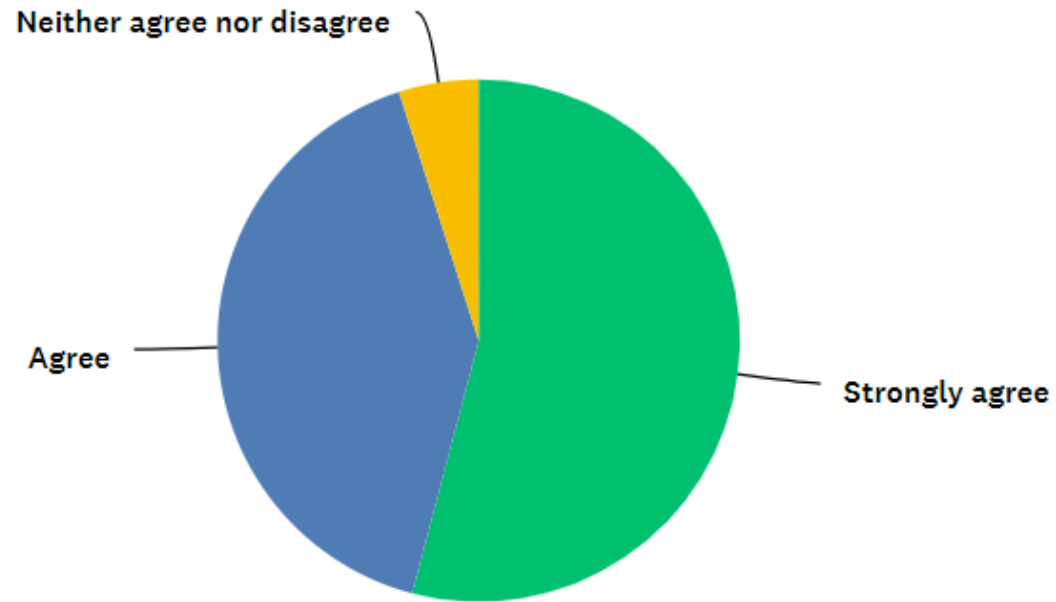

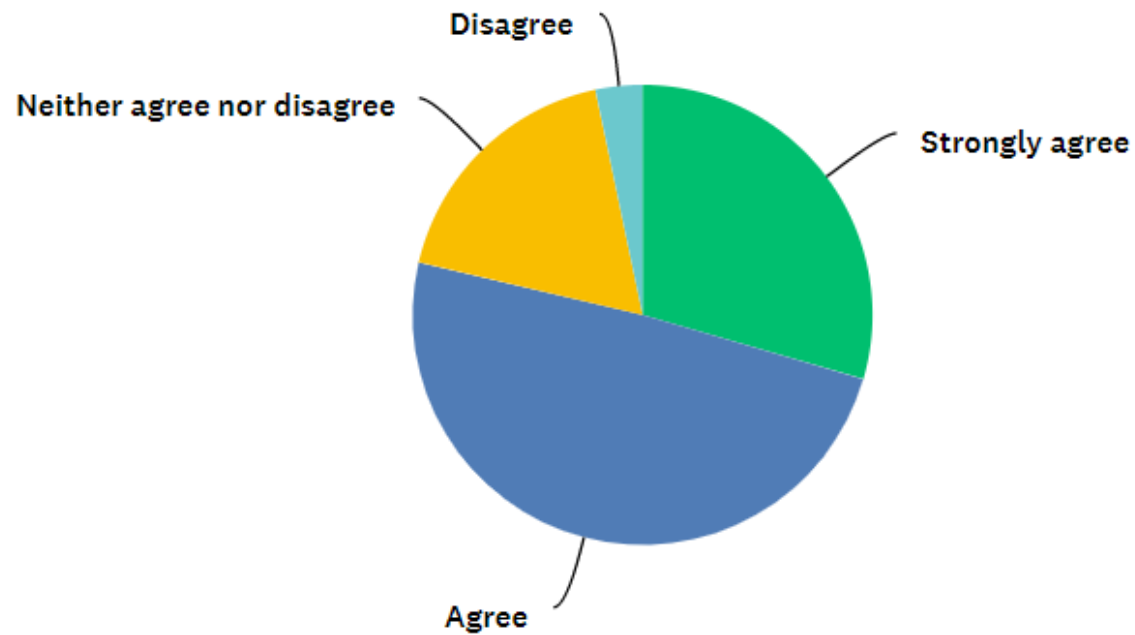

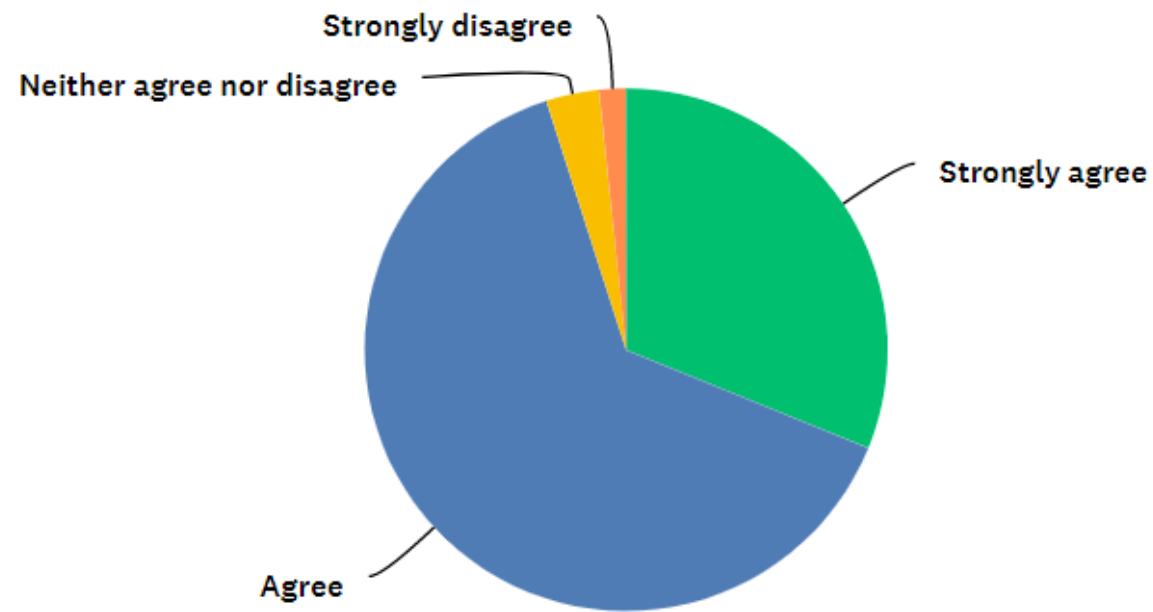

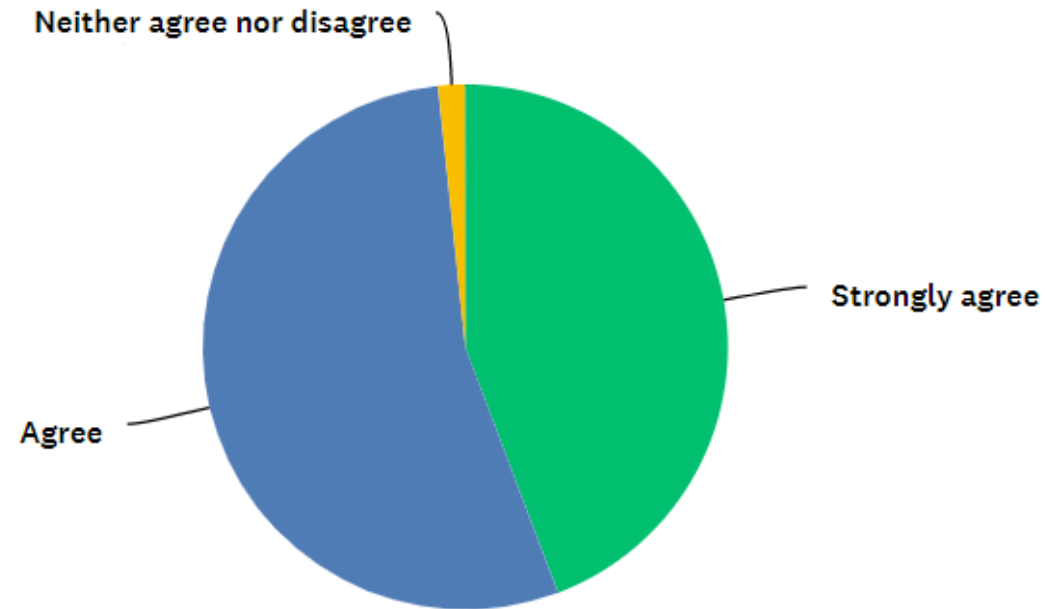

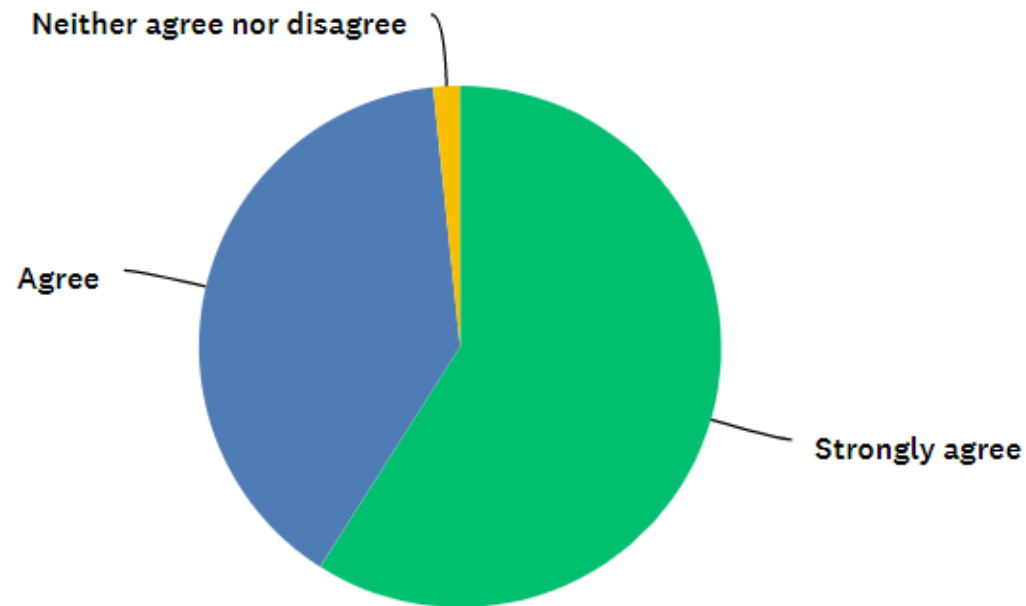

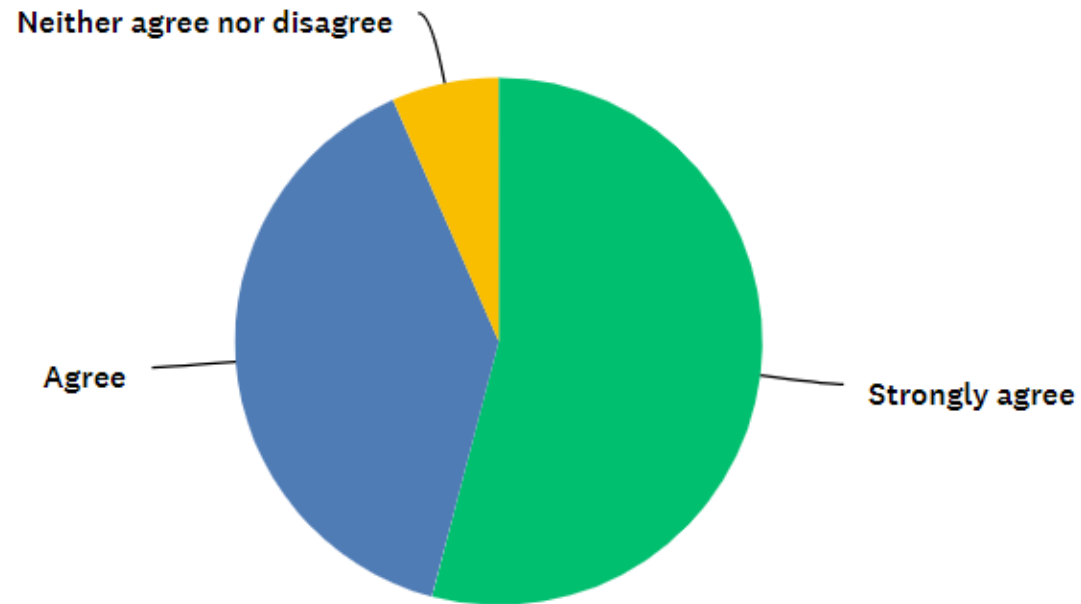

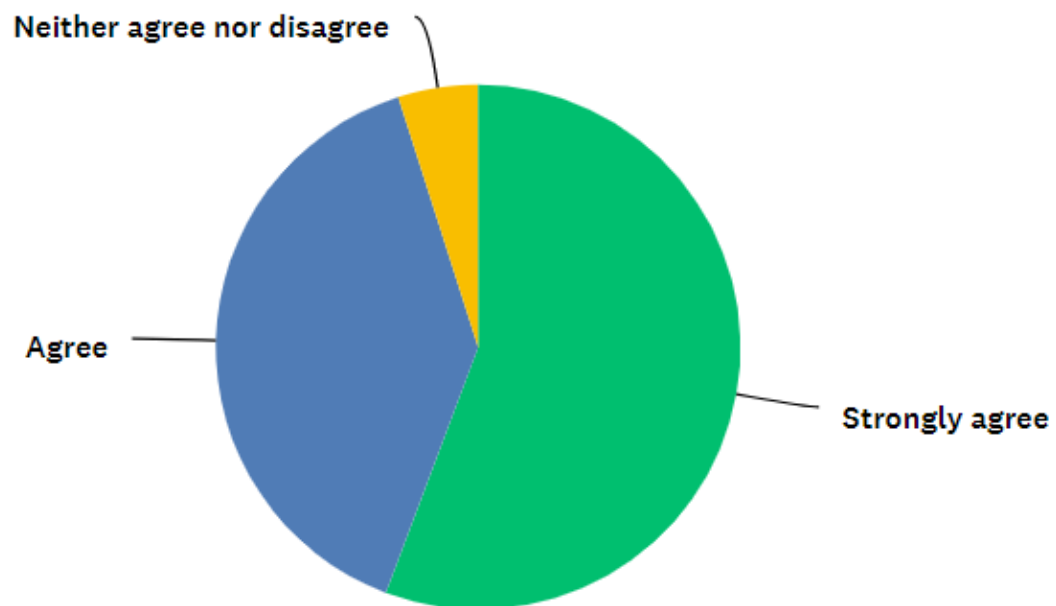
