



1. How much do you agree with the following? The day was about the right length. If disagree/Strongly disagree please explain why in Other






2. How much do you agree with the following? The day was well organised, I knew when and how to log on, and how to ask questions. If disagree/Strongly disagree please explain why in Other








5. Considering the Challenges for the mother and the new born session, please indicate how much you agree with the following 'the content was appropriate and the delivery was excellent' Please explain in Other




6. Considering the Breastfeeding for the long term session, please indicate how much you agree with the following 'the content was appropriate and the delivery was excellent' Please explain in Other



- Yes
